Pauline presented the current status of our finances

Fence

Damage Repair

- Sid has contacted the IFFT fence company regarding details of the warranty for the damaged portion of the fence previously replaced by their company. (The warranty was for winds up to 75 MPH)
- IFFT indicated that they will check with manufacturer and will get back with Sid.
- Sid also asked for a bid on the repair of the other damaged panels as well

Damage Assessment

- 5 Panels are currently down in addition to the original damage on the end toward the detention basin.
- The board discussed how we might be able to reinforce/brace the end panel of the fence.
- Board discussed that we may need some spacing between panels to keep fence from being blown down in the future.

Suggestions on Repairs

 It was decided that we would wait to hear from IFFT regarding the warranty and then we will proceed with a repair plan

Long Term Plan

- Bud is investigating other types of fencing available to replace our current vinyl fence
- We will continue to look for long term solutions

Retention Basin/Pond update -Watershed Credit

Details

- Bud has met with city engineer
- Our detention basin does qualify for the Watershed credit
- We are not the owners of the detention basin Snyder is. We have to be owners of the
 detention basin to quality for the credit.
- Bud has also talked to the Ireland Grove subdivision. It is possible that they can be included
 in watershed credit. Mike Gilmore is the president of the HOA in addition to helping our
 subdivision pay for costs associated with the detention basin.
- Bud has not yet talked to the Brookridge subdivision
- We could use any money we get from other subdivisions to build a fund for future detention basin expenses
- Bud is waiting for Snyder to call back regarding ownership of the detention basin before proceeding

Tree Replacement on Berm

- F&W provided a bid for eight trees/planted in the amount of \$3800.00
- Kickapoo Creek Nursery provided a bid in the amount of \$3000.00 for seven trees/planting but not much variety in the trees
- Dustin will contact Grieders and possibly Growing Grounds for additional bids
- Board is not yet sure how many trees will be replaced and when. This will depend on our finances.
